

Terms and Conditions of www.ellert.pl

1. General provisions and definitions:

The terms used in these Terms and Conditions shall have the following meanings:

1. Website – the website available at www.ellert.pl containing services and products provided and produced by the Owner.

2. Owner – Drukarnia Ellert Sp. z o.o. with its registered office at Nadrzeczna 17 str., 05-462, Wiązowna, National Court Register No.: 0000198110, VAT No.: 5321851537, National Official Business Register No.: 015621791

3. User – a person using the Website in accordance with the Terms and Conditions and having full legal capacity.

4. Terms and Conditions – these Terms and Conditions governing the use of the Website by the Users.

2. Website

2.1. The Website is the official corporate site of Drukarnia Ellert Sp. z o.o. and contains the Owner's services and product images.

3. Industrial and intellectual property rights
